



Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Pasadena to Azusa

Re: Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Light Rail Project

Dear Neighbor:

The start of major construction for the Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension from Pasadena to Azusa is approaching. The project will extend light rail service 11.5-miles with 6 new stations from Pasadena to Azusa. Major construction of this light rail line is expected to begin this month in your area and is scheduled for completion in late 2015 at which time the Foothill Extension is turned over to Metro for testing. Metro determines when revenue service begins.

Over the next three years, there will be a significant amount of construction activity on the railroad corridor and on adjacent city streets. The Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Construction Authority (Construction Authority), the agency overseeing the project, and Foothill Transit Constructors (FTC, the design-build team) would like to keep you informed of construction and other project-related issues.

Prior to planned construction activities, the Construction Authority distributes construction notices to the communities adjacent to the upcoming work. Construction Notices include a description and the location of the work activity, anticipated dates and time of scheduled work, and what community impacts to expect. We will distribute these construction notices door-to-door to residents and businesses in the vicinity of the upcoming work. In addition, the Construction Authority emails an electronic version of the notice to constituents who have requested to it.

We strongly encourage you to provide your email address to the Construction Authority in order for you to be included in all future construction notice distributions. Please visit www.foothillextension.org to take advantage of this free service.

Additionally, the Construction Authority is offering tours of the operational Metro Gold Line from Pasadena to Union Station in Los Angeles for interested residents, business representatives and community organizations. Contact Sylvia Beltran if you are interested in taking a tour.
